

The Great Pumpkin Weigh-Off [TGPWO]

Get involved with pumpkin growing . . . with your kids, your grandkids, your friends and neighbors!

FOR FREE, we provide: 2 plants per participant, each planted BOMay 2011 [actually May 3, 2011], one parent weighed 947lbs; “How To” growing sheet including info on pests, fertilizers, info sources; prizes to winners

IN RETURN, we require: participant to pick up their own plants during the last two weeks of May/first two weeks of June 2011; participant’s *entry registration** into the TGPWO contest hosted by/at The Great Pumpkin Patch on Sat, 10/1/11; and participant’s full responsibility of transporting their giant pumpkin to TGPP grounds of their own accord no earlier than 8:00am on Sept 30, and no later than 10:00am on Oct 1, 2011.

The info TGPP can provide to any participant is a suggested growing space size (10’ × 10’ space within garden site), and soil prep info prior to actual transplanting (apply heavy organic compost into 2’ × 2’ spot where plant will be transplanted). Both of these tips are per TGPP’s general manager who will also be participating in this contest with his three young children.

* *Entry registration* includes disclaimer that TGPP cannot replace the plants, answer any questions once the plants leave TGPP grounds, be responsible for any acts or elements of nature. TGPP management reserves the right to visit these giant pumpkins at participant’s growing site between June 1 and Sept 30, 2011; and reserves the right for press coverage of these giant pumpkins at TGPP’s discretion, **providing minimum 24-hour notice to participants**. The *entry registration* rules that participant’s must allow their giant pumpkin to be situated on TGPP grounds from Oct 1, 2011 through Oct 23, 2011 with all details of this giant pumpkin made public. Participant must retrieve their giant pumpkin no later than Oct 25, 2011, or else relinquish all ownership rights of their giant pumpkin to TGPP. Participant’s signature on this *entry registration* confirms full compliance with the stated rules and disclaimers herein.
